ORDINANCE NO. 120363

An Ordinance vacating certain portions of S.E.13th Avenue and S.E. Martins Street, under certain conditions.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that on March 1, 1965 Ronald D. and Bettie Jane Mayer, 6115 S.E. 13th Avenue, Portland, Oregon, and others filed a petition for the vacation of certain portions of S.E. 13th Avenue and S.E. Martins Street in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Gregon, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of 3.E 13th Avenue between the north line of S.E Martins Street and the south line of 3.E. Yukon Street and said S.E. Martins Street between the east line of vacated 3.E. 12th Avenue and the west line of 3.E. 13th Avenue:

that the purpose of said vacation is for general residential improvement, particularly to increase residential yard area; that pursuant to CRS 271.130 the Council fixed a time and place for public hearing before the Council; that the City Auditor published notice of such nearing in the City official newspaper, namely, the Daily Journal of Commerce in certain places in area proposed to be vacated, all in accordance with provisions of ORS 271.110; said matter came on regularly for hearing and no bjections were made or filed thereto and it is in the public interest that said street be vacated; that consents for said vacation have bein received from the Commission of Public Docks and from the Port of Portland, as required by law, and that said vacation will not interfere with any improvement proposed by the Commission of Public Docks nor with reasonable access to the water front or transportation terminal; now, therefore, that certain area of streets hereinbefore described hereby is vacated under the following conditions:

- 1. That petitioners pay all costs incidental to the vacation;
- 2. Nothing herein contained shall cause or require the removal or abandonment of any sewer, water or gas main, conduit of any kind, wire, pole or thing used, or intended to be used, for any public service, and the right hereby is reserved for the owner of any such utility or thing to maintain, continue, repair, reconstruct, renew, replace, rebuild, and/or enlarge any and all such things; that no buildings or structures of any kind shall be built or erected within a distance of ten feet from the center line of any such utility, except with the written consent of the City

Engineer and the owner of the utility first had, and that any and all contemplated building plans in said vacated area shall be submitted for approval to the City Engineer and to the Director of the Bureau of Buildings, to the end that such construction may be so adjusted with reference to all public utilities in said area as to cause a minimum of danger or inconvenience to the public and to the owner of such utility and to protect and preserve the same as presently constructed or hereafter reconstructed, renewed, replaced and/or enlarged.

3. Petitioners shall file in the office of the City Auditor, in form approved by the City Attorney, a document in writing accepting the terms and conditions of this ordinance.

Section 2 The City Auditor shall file with the recorder, t assessor, and the surveyor of the county in which said vacation is located, a certified copy of this ordinance and the acceptance thereof, and any map, plat or other record which may be required by law.
