

ORDINANCE No. 125209

An Ordinance authorizing the execution of a pipeline crossing agreement with the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, permitting installation and maintenance of a sewer pipe across railroad right-of-way at Wakefield and Peninsula Junction, and declaring an emergency.


The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that it is necessary to cross railroad right-of-way with a sewer pipe at what is designated Wakefield and Peninsula Junction in connection with construction of the Linnton-Guilds Lake Interceptor Sewer System; that in order to obtain the necessary permission, it is necessary that a pipeline crossing agreement be executed with the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company; now, therefore, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Works are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Portland a pipeline crossing agreement with Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, the form of such agreement shall be subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.


Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the construction of the necessary sewer line may proceed without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
