## ORDINANCE No. 126234

An Ordinance transferring \$600 within the General Fund from Equipment Adjustment to Office of the City Attorney, Equipment, to purchase books, The Urban Affairs Reporter, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that The Urban Affairs Reporter would be a useful tool for the City Attorney's task of locating federal aid for the City and should be purchased; that provision was not made for such purchase in the appropriate budget account and a transfer of funds is necessary for such purchase; and that the Commissioner in charge of the Office of the City Attorney has recommended that such transfer of funds be made for said purchase; now, therefore, the sum of \$600 is hereby transferred within the General Fund from Equipment Adjustment (3830) to the Office of the City Attorney, Equipment (600.720) and the City Auditor is hereby directed to make the necessary entries to accomplish said transfer.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no delay in providing funds for the purchase referred to in Section 1 hereof; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
