overtime parking of motor vehicles and general abuse of parking privileges, and to afford adequate control and regulation of traffic moving to and from the congested district, and for the purpose of establishing an efficient system applicable for the enforcement of parking regulations, and to facilitate a greater freedom for the motor vehicle user in transacting business requiring a relatively short period of time within the district as hereinafter designated and as an exercise of the police power, the installation, use and maintenance of parking meters in the city is hereby authorized.

16.36.020 Maintenance. The commissioner in charge of the bureau of traffic engineering through the bureau hereby is authorized to maintain in the designated districts of the city parking meters on each side of the streets and avenues situated in the parking meter districts as hereinafter defined by Section 16.36.030. The parking meters shall be maintained under conditions prescribed by the commissioner. All replacements of the parking meters now in operation or additional parking meters hereafter installed, shall be of such material, design and appearance, visibility of indicators, visibility of coin locks, finish, and designations as shall be determined by the council. The commissioner shall provide for the installation, regulation, control and operation of the use and maintenance of all parking meters now installed or hereafter installed. Each parking meter shall be so set as to display a signal showing legal parking upon the deposit of a specified coin or coins of the United States therein for a period of time conforming to the parking limits provided for in Section 16.36.040 and 16.36.050. Each parking meter shall by its device clearly set out and continue in operation from the time of deposit of such coin until the expiration of the time fixed as the parking limit for the part of the street or avenue upon which the parking meter is placed. Each parking meter shall also be so arranged that upon the expiration of the parking time limit the parking meter will indicate by mechanical or automatic operation and the appearance of proper signal that the proper lawful parking period has expired.

16.36.030 Parking meter areas. Parking meters subject to designated time limits as provided in Section 16.36.040 hereof are hereby authorized within the following areas of the

city:

(1) Beginning at the southeast corner of the intersection of S. W. Front Avenue and S. W. Grant Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of S. W. Grant Street to the westerly line of S. W. Broadway; thence northerly along the westerly line of S. W. Broadway to the southerly line of S. W. Jackson Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of S. W. Jackson Street to the westerly line of S. W. 11th Avenue; thence northerly along the westerly line of S. W. 11th Avenue to the southerly line of S. W. College Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of S. W. College Street to the westerly line of S. W. 14th Avenue; thence northerly along the westerly line of S. W. 14th Avenue to the southerly line of S. W. Salmon Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of S. W. Salmon Street to the westerly line of S. W. 21st Avenue; thence north along the westerly line of S. W. 21st Avenue to the southerly line of W. Burnside Street; thence west along the southerly line of W. Burnside Street to the easterly line of N. W. 23rd Avenue; thence north to the northerly line of W. Burnside Street; thence east along the northerly line of W. Burnside Street to the westerly line of N. W. 21st Avenue; thence north along the westerly line of N. W. 21st Avenue to the northerly line of N. W. Kearney Street; thence east along the northerly line of N. W. Kearney Street to the easterly line of N. W. 12th Avenue; thence south along the easterly line of N. W. 12th Avenue to the northerly line of N. W. Hoyt Street; thence east along the northerly line of N. W. Hoyt Street to the easterly line of N. W. Broadway; thence north along the easterly line of N. W. Broadway, produced north, to the northerly line of N. W. Johnson Street; thence east along the northerly line of N. W. Johnson Street to the easterly line of N. W. 6th Avenue; thence south along the easterly line of N. W. 6th Avenue to the northerly line of N. W. Irving Street; thence east along the northerly line of N. W. Irving Street to the easterly line of N. W. 5th Avenue; thence south along the easterly line of N. W. 5th Avenue to the northerly line of N. W. Hoyt Street; thence east along the northerly line of N. W. Hoyt Street to the easterly line of N. W. 3rd Avenue; thence south along the easterly line of N. W. 3rd Avenue to the southerly line of N. W. Glisan Street; thence east along the southerly line of N. W. Glisan Street to the easterly line of N. W. Front

Avenue; thence south along the easterly line of N. W. Front Avenue and S. W. Front Avenue to the point of beginning.

(2) Beginning at the northwest corner of N. E. Union Avenue and Weidler Street; thence easterly along the north line of N. E. Weidler Street to N. E. 15th Avenue; thence south along the east line of N. E. 15th Avenue to N. E. Holladay Way; thence south along the east line of N. E. Holladay Way to N. E. Holladay Street; thence west along the south line of N. E. Holladay Street to N. E. 11th Avenue; thence south along the east line of N. E. 11th Avenue to N. E. Lloyd Boulevard; thence west along the south line of N. E. Lloyd Boulevard to N. E. Grand Avenue; thence south along the east line of N. E. Grand Avenue to E. Burnside Street; thence west along the south line of E. Burnside Street to S. E. Union Avenue; thence north along the west line of Union Avenue to N. E. Weidler Street to the point of beginning.

16.36.040 Time limit. The time limit for parking on streets and avenues of the city within the area designated for the installation of parking meters, and where such meters are actually installed, shall be fifteen minutes, thirty minutes, one hour, two hours, or additional time as determined by the traffic engineer with the approval of the commissioner in charge of the bureau of traffic engineering, and as shown on the meter.

16.36.050 Fees. A parking meter fee shall be paid by all persons parking a motor vehicle within any metered parking space in the area designated in Section 16.36.030 in the amount indicated by a sign or legend to be installed on or adjacent to such meter. The sign or legend shall indicate the interval of time for which parking is permitted and the fee payable for each fifteen minutes, thirty minutes or hour; provided, however, that parking meter space may be used without charge during all hours on Sundays, New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Any parking meter space may, unless otherwise designated by sign or legend on or adjacent thereto, be occupied without payment of fee between the hours of six p.m. and eight a.m.; provided, however, that such hours of free occupancy of parking meter spaces may from time to time be extended or restricted as to

designated areas upon order of the traffic engineer with the approval of the commissioner in charge of the bureau of traffic engineering. It is unlawful for any person subject to the provisions of this chapter to permit any motor vehicle in his control or custody to remain in any parking meter space longer than the time designated for such space by the depositing of an additional coin or coins in the parking meter. Commercial vehicles may use parking meter space for a maximum of twenty minutes on any one stop, while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or performing a service, without charge on any day prior to ten-thirty a.m. or after six p.m.

16.36.060 Space to be designated. The commissioner in charge of the bureau of traffic engineering, through the bureau, shall place lines or marks on the curb or on the street adjacent to each parking meter to designate the parking space for which the parking meter is to be used. Where a double-headed meter is used, lines or marks designating the two parking spaces it regulates shall be painted on the street and, where necessary, a maneuvering area shall be provided, designated by an X mark painted on the street. It is unlawful to park any motor vehicle across a line or mark designating a parking space, or between such lines in a maneuvering area designated by an X mark.

16.36.070 Parking in meter parking place. When any motor vehicle is parked in a space regulated by a parking meter under Section 16.36.050, the owner, operator or person having custody of such motor vehicle shall, upon entering the parking space, immediately deposit one or more coins of the United States in the parking meter adjacent to the parking space as indicated on the sign or legend on or adjacent to the meter. The parking space then may be used by that motor vehicle during the parking interval paid for by the deposit of coin. If the motor vehicle remains in such parking space other than during the parking interval paid for, the parking meter will display a sign showing illegal parking and such motor vehicle shall be considered parked overtime. It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow or suffer any motor vehicle registered in his name to be parked overtime.

16.36.080 Extension of parking time prohibited. It is unlawful for any person to
