*Accept a grant of \$39,145 from East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District for Veteran's Creek Restoration (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. BES applied to EMSWCD for a grant in the amount of \$39,145 for Veteran's Creek Restoration on March 12, 2010; and
- 2. EMSWCD has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Veteran's Creek Restoration to BES in the amount of \$39,145.

NOW THEREFORE, the council directs:

- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
