

**ORDINANCE No. 184100**

\*Accept a grant of \$39,145 from East Multnomah Soil and Water Conservation District for Veteran's Creek Restoration (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. BES applied to EMSWCD for a grant in the amount of \$39,145 for Veteran's Creek Restoration on March 12, 2010; and
2. EMSWCD has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Veteran's Creek Restoration to BES in the amount of \$39,145.

NOW THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from EMSWCD for Veteran's Creek Restoration in the amount of \$39,145 and to execute a grant agreement in substantially the same form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Business Area - ES00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$2,344

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
