7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The annual City Combined Charitable Campaign provides a means for charitable organizations to solicit contributions from City employees. The standards and guidelines for the Combined Charitable Campaign were adopted as Chapter 5.10 of the City Code in 1989 through Ordinance No. 161964.

The Charitable Campaign has proved to be a substantial source of funds for Portland's local charities. The City's annual Combined Charitable Campaign offers our employees the choice of giving to multiple community funds and federations. This type of campaign offers choice, benefits our community greatly, and is extremely efficient.

Under Code Chapter 5.10, charitable organizations may only participate in the charity drive as a member of an umbrella organization and must by approved by City Council based on compliance with eligibility requirements set forth in Code Section 5.10.050. (A waiver of the requirement to be an umbrella organization was provided for the Portland Toy & Joymakers in ordinance 178446 and for the Portland Parks Foundation in ordinance 178447.)

This ordinance authorizes the listed charitable umbrella organizations and their member organizations to participate in the City's 2011 Combined Charitable Campaign which will kick off in October. The Office of Management and Finance's Business Operations Division will coordinate and facilitate the campaign with the assistance of the participating charities.
