ORDINANCE No. 184121

*Authorize CityFleet to purchase replacement police patrol vehicles at \$1,144,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all Cityowned vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of the Police Bureau patrol sedans.
- 3. It has been determined that 52 patrol sedans need to be ordered in FY 2010-2011.
- 4. The estimated cost of these vehicles is \$1,144,000.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to determine the best selection method and to bring a recommendation back to City Council for approval in accordance with City Code 5.33.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchases from the CityFleet Replacement Fund.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of the amount of time it takes for the factory manufacturing processes and local outfitting of these specialty patrol sedans. CityFleet, in conjunction with Purchases, will consider cost, capability, and available dealerships as criteria when making the selection. The order needs to be placed as soon as possible in order to have these vehicles available for the Police to use in the Spring of 2011. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
