Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City titled a 2009 trailer (Vehicle #098009), which had been purchased with funds from the Regional Water Providers Consortium. The Consortium has now decided that the trailer title should be transferred to Clackamas River Water (CRW).
- 2. An Intergovernmental Agreement is being finalized between CRW and the Consortium, which outlines the roles and responsibilities for maintenance of the trailer.
- 3. CRW agrees to hold harmless, defend and indemnify the City, its officers, agents and employees from any claims, demands, actions, and suits (including attorney fees) arising from this title transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Systems/Office of Management and Finance is hereby authorized to transfer ownership of this trailer for \$0.00.
- b. The Bureau of Internal Business Services, through the CityFleet Division, is authorized to provide CRW with the appropriate documentation needed to transfer ownership of the trailer.
