1) Legislation Title:

Approve Intergovernmental Agreement with the East Multnomah Soil & Water Conservation District through their Partners in Conservation Program (Ordinance).

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

An ordinance is required in order to accept any intergovernmental agreement/grant.

3) Revenue:

Accepting this intergovernmental agreement/grant will fund \$15,925 in expenditures for the Neighborhood Forest Management Plans.

A \$15,925 cash match is required by this agreement and is currently budgeted. In addition, an in-kind match of \$45,000 is required, and will be met with volunteer hours.

The funding of \$15,925 will be budgeted in the Fall BMP and will fund:

- \$11,200: Two casual employees, 800 hours each
- \$3,100: Equipment
- \$1,625: Supplies and materials


