An Ordinance accepting a Warranty Deed for four (4) buffer strips in the plat Summerplace - Phase III, granted by Hayden Corporation, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The plat of Summerplace Phase III dedicated certain streets which terminate at the perimeter of said plat and are to be extended to serve adjacent property when said property has been approved for development.
- 2. The buffer strips are needed to prevent the extension of said streets until approved for development.
- The buffer strips shall be designated as public street rightof-way by Ordinance when said streets are extended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The acceptance of a warranty deed for four (4) access control buffer strips, described as follow:

Tracts S, T, U and V, Summerplace - Phase III, in the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon. (Granted by Hayden Corporation, Attn: Wyn Plocher, Dept. of Planning & Design, 900 N Tomahawk Island Dr., Suite 125, Portland, OR 97217.)

- b. The Auditor shall record in the appropriate deed records, documents of title necessary for acquisition of the buffer strips.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in the acceptance of the warranty deed might jeopardize the City's ability to control future development beyond Summerplace Phase III; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
