## ORDINANCE No. 184144

\*Authorize settlement between the Portland Police Association and the City of Portland through its Portland Police Bureau regarding employment claims (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau (PPB) issued a 300-hour suspension without pay to Scherise Hobbs. The Portland Police Association ("PPA") grieved the suspension. The City denied the grievance and the PPA advanced the grievance to arbitration.
- 2. The parties now desire to compromise and settle the grievance.
- 3. As part of the proposed settlement, PPB agrees to rescind the 300-hour suspension without pay and reissue a 120-hour suspension without pay. PPB will restore 119 hours of accrued vacation to Hobbs, which she forfeited as part of the original suspension. PPB will reimburse Hobbs for 61 hours of pay at the hourly rate of \$32.28 (which was her rate of pay at the time she served the suspension).
- 4. As part of the proposed settlement, PPA agrees to withdraw the grievance with prejudice and split equally the arbitrator's fees, if any.
- 5. PPB and the City Attorney's Office recommend acceptance of the proposed settlement.
- 6. Per PCC 3.15.050, the Director of the Bureau of Human Resources has reviewed and approved the proposed settlement.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Commissioner Dan Saltzman is authorized to execute the proposed settlement agreement on behalf of the City. A copy of the Settlement Agreement is attached as Exhibit 1.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
