

RESOLUTION No. 3 6 81 7

Accept the Master Plan for Leach Botanical Garden as a guide for future development and management of the garden (Resolution)

WHEREAS the site was acquired by Portland Parks & Recreation for a botanical garden and opened to the public in 1982; and

WHEREAS, the garden is located on SE 122nd Avenue, south of Foster Avenue, in Southeast Portland; and

WHEREAS, the site includes the home and gardens of John Leach and his wife Lilla, a renowned botanist; and

WHEREAS, the garden is managed by the Leach Garden Friends with significant contributions from Portland Parks & Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the site is one of the few local botanical gardens with a significant educational program; and

WHEREAS, the garden attracts horticulturalists and botanists from around the country and the world who are interested in Northwest plants in their native microclimates; and

WHEREAS, the garden can accommodate a variety of educational, cultural and natural resource activities that serve the city and the immediate neighborhood; and


WHEREAS, the garden provides significant publicly-owned green space for relaxation and contemplation in an area of increasing density; and

WHEREAS, the plan was prepared with the assistance of a steering committee made up of representatives from Pleasant Valley Neighborhood Association, the Johnson Creek Watershed Council, the immediate neighborhood, the Board of the Leach Garden Friends, garden volunteers, persons with plant collection and land use planning expertise; and

WHEREAS, there were two public open houses, and a newsletter to the neighbors explaining the master plan process and the recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, affirms its acceptance of the master plan for Leach Botanical Garden as the city's guide to the future development and management of the garden.




