Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Argyle & 13<sup>th</sup> Pump Station Remodel Project No. E08874 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to remodel the existing Argyle & 13<sup>th</sup> Pump Station. Remodel is necessary due to equipment condition and age; to address safety, reliability, and maintenance access issues; and to comply with current regulatory requirements.
2. The upgrade of the Argyle & 13<sup>th</sup> Pump Station has been identified as a priority project within the BES Pump Station Improvement Program.
3. The estimated cost is \$1,048,000. The level of confidence in the estimated construction cost is Optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project No. E08874.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


