

ORDINANCE No. 184160

*Authorize application to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for a Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund grant of \$1,000,000 for brownfield cleanup activities (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland is committed to encouraging the remediation of brownfield sites within the City.
2. The EPA's Brownfield Revolving Loan Fund Grant Program provides funding for a grant recipient to capitalize a revolving fund and to make loans and provide sub-grants to carry out cleanup activities.
3. BES is preparing a grant application to submit to EPA requesting funds in the amount of \$1,000,000.
4. The grant from EPA requires a 20% non-federal match. Local match in the amount of \$200,000 will be provided in the form of salary and benefits in the FY 2011/2012, FY 2012/2013, FY 2013/2014, FY 2014/2015, and FY 2015/2016 proposed budgets of the Bureau of Environmental Services. Matching funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, Bureau of Environmental Services, ESPP000017 / PUPPECBF000000BE.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to the EPA for a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance's Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be delivered by October 15, 2010. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
