## ORDINANCE No. 184161

\*Authorize application to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for a \$200,000 grant for Brownfield Petroleum Assessment (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland is committed to encouraging the remediation of brownfield sites within the City.
- 2. The EPA's Brownfield Assessment Grant Program provides funds to inventory, characterize, assess, and conduct planning (including cleanup planning) and community involvement related to brownfield sites.
- 3. BES is preparing a grant application to submit to EPA requesting funds in the amount of \$200,000 to perform environmental site assessments on publicly and privately owned petroleum brownfield properties with a target area of Outer East Portland.
- 4. The grant from EPA does not require local match.

## NOW THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make an application to the EPA for a grant in the amount of \$200,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be delivered by October 15, 2010. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
