

**ORDINANCE No. 184167**

\* Authorize a grant agreement with Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano to assist victims and survivors of domestic violence not to exceed \$50,000 per year for 5 years (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Police Bureau responds to many calls involving domestic violence.
2. Victims of domestic violence frequently feel isolated with nowhere to turn for help and support.
3. Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano provides resources, support and assistance to victims, survivors, and children of domestic violence. Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano has been providing advocates for victims of domestic violence where weapons or threat of weapons are used.
4. Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano provides domestic violence advocates to aid victims of domestic violence through their guidance, safety planning, referrals and assistance to successfully navigate through the legal system.
5. The funds for this grant agreement were specifically provided as ongoing General Fund appropriation for the Police Bureau in the FY 2009-10 Adopted Budget in order to provide advocacy services for the victims of domestic violence.
6. The term of this agreement is July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015 with a not to exceed amount of \$50,000 per year.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this grant agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City, Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano and victims of domestic violence in Portland of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
