

<b>PROJECT TITLE AND DESCRIPTION</b> Portland Clean Diesel Partnership This assistance agreement provides funding to the City of Portland under the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act of 2009. This project will allow the purchase and installation of verified diesel particulate filters, partial flow filters and diesel oxidation catalysts on construction equipment. Fuel fired heaters are also proposed for equipment owned by Portland and Multnomah County. This funding will also be used to pilot a clean diesel contracting policy. This project will retrofit approximately 161 pieces of equipment and install 237 fuel-operated heaters which will reduce diesel emissions. This project will also provide approximately 34.3 jobs.
