

ORDINANCE NO. 184179

*Authorize application to Metro for a grant in the amount of \$80,000 for the Bicycle Parking in Underserved Communities project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Metro's Regional Travel Options program is soliciting transportation demand management projects that promote transportation options and reduce vehicle miles travelled in the region.
2. The Regional Travel Options program's five year strategic plan calls for increasing access to bicycle parking along Metro designated Main Streets and Town Centers across the region.
3. Since 2007 the Bureau of Transportation's SmartTrips Business program has worked with over 400 businesses in Portland to provide resources for employers wishing to promote transportation options at their workplace; when possible the program works with business owners to install bicycle parking in the City's right of way through the Bureau's existing bicycle parking program.
4. In 2010, the SmartTrips Business program focused its efforts on businesses in East Portland, reaching over 150 businesses, however the program was unable to provide bicycle parking to the over fifty businesses that requested bicycle parking through the program due to constraints in the right-of-way.
5. The Bureau of Transportation is also experiencing an increase in demand for bicycle parking at schools, the current bicycle parking program does not have the resources to meet this demand.
6. The Bicycle Parking in Underserved Communities project aims to provide a pool of up to 700 bicycle parking racks and installation resources to be made available to businesses and schools that request bicycle parking through the Bureau's SmartTrips Business and Safe Routes to School programs. Business will be required to install the racks on private property, and fifty percent of the resources will be dedicated to business in East Portland.
7. City of Portland matching funds of \$80,000 shall be in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2011-12 budget of the Bureau of Transportation.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Metro for a grant in the amount of \$80,000.

- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant is due immediately; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


