This Contract was made and entered by and between <u>Cale Parking Systems USA, Inc.</u>, hereinafter called Contractor, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives, hereinafter called City.

- 1. Include pay station wireless services through AT&T at appropriate service levels through the Cale Help Desk Services.
- 2. With a goal of striving for 100% online communication functionality, Cale will monitor all pay stations on a daily basis to evaluate weak spots and/or pay stations that have gone offline. If an area of the City is showing a "down tower", Cale will immediately open a ticket with AT&T to evaluate the "communication down" status. Cale will document all AT&T actions and keep the City informed on all status changes. In order to prevent communication drops from the pay station side, the combination of the City supporting the routine preventive maintenance program combined with Cale monitoring the status should result in an online percentage that is acceptable to the City.
- 3. Compensation is \$8.95 per pay station per month; in the first year, necessary hardware will be included for up to \$20,000.
- 4. Amendment 5 extended Help Desk Services through June 30, 2015, and should have extended therm through the end of the contract, June 30, 2016.
- 5. Additional compensation is necessary and shall not exceed \$1,301,264 over the remaining years of the contract's life.
- 6. Total compensation for this contract shall not exceed \$20,031,749.

All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
