

ORDINANCE NO. 184185

* Amend subrecipient contract with Human Solutions, Inc. to add \$25,000 in HOME fund for services in support of affordable housing. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000433)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) is committed to fund organizations that provide a broad continuum of assistance and services for low income homeowners and renters.
2. PHB currently has Contract No. 32000433 with Human Solutions, Inc. to provide services in support of affordable housing.
3. PHB desires to increase Human Solutions' contract budget by \$25,000 in HOME fund for a revised total compensation not to exceed \$123,134.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Subrecipient Contract No. 32000433 with Human Solutions, Inc. in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to make payment chargeable to the FY 2010-11 Budget when demand is presented and approved by proper authority.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt Human Solutions, Inc.'s ability to provide the services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.


