To better coordinate and more efficiently implement the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP), Multnomah County and the City agreed to submit a joint application to Oregon Housing and Community Services (OHCS). This ordinance will authorize the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the County that will govern the NSP work and the use of NSP funds.

The combined City and County NSP funding totals \$3,538,217, and is comprised of \$3,255,159 in program funds and \$283,057 in administrative funds. These funds are:

- providing 17 home buyers up to \$50,000 in down payment, closing costs, and rehabilitation assistance;
- acquiring, rehabilitating, and returning to the market 9 foreclosed homes that will remain permanently affordable through the use of the land trust model employed by Proud Ground and the Native American Youth and Family Center

- enabling Habitat for Humanity Portland Metro/East to acquire a foreclosed property upon which they will build 45 condominiums for households between 30% and 60% of the Median Area Income.
