Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools to provide \$70,000 for durable lunch trays. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland has adopted aggressive climate and sustainability goals that rely on reducing total solid waste generated in the local environment.
2. The Climate Action Plan, adopted by Council on October 28, 2009, directs the City of Portland to work with partner organizations to encourage businesses and residents to purchase durable, repairable and reusable goods; to reduce the amount of materials that go to waste; and to reduce consumption of carbon-intensive consumer goods and services.
3. Funding durable lunch trays for Portland Public Schools will provide critical resources for transitioning from disposable polystyrene foam trays to permanent ware in the 2010-2011 school year. Switching to durable trays will significantly reduce solid waste generation at the schools as 14,700 disposable trays are used each school day.
4. The additional benefit of establishing reuse practices among students is a valuable waste reduction lesson.
5. Portland Public Schools Nutrition Services has conducted pilot permanent ware programs at 17 schools within the Portland Public Schools system and now seeks to expand the program through much of the district. Funds are needed to cover the start-up purchase costs for trays, as well as costs for the staff time required to wash trays. Provision of durable trays will allow Portland Public Schools to avoid costs for purchase, warehousing and transport of disposable trays.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Portland Public Schools in a form substantially similar to that attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw warrants in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 from SAP account #9PNSWC000001.




