

## ORDINANCE No. 184200

\*Call for bids and authorize contract for construction of US 26 Adaptive Signal System Safety Improvements project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 183068, passed by the Council on August, 2009, authorized the acceptance of a grant agreement in the amount of \$1,639,677 with Oregon Department of Transportation for the implementation of the US 26 Adaptive Signal System project that will optimize traffic signal timing along US 26, from Milwaukie Avenue to 52<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.
2. City staff will use the newly installed adaptive signal system, closed circuit television (CCTV) cameras, fiber optic and Bluetooth Travel Time technology to monitor traffic conditions, relieve congestion, enhance safety, and increase efficiency of the existing transportation system.
3. The design work needed to prepare plans, specifications and an estimate for the project construction has been completed.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to award, execute and provide payment for a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing a contract will cause a delay in completion of the project within the upcoming construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


