7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Fifty percent of two positions have been funded through the Emergency Management Performance Grant annually for the last decade. The funding also pays for office supplies, training and planning coordination and office space.

The Work Plan this year encompassed completing state required training, NIMS compliance, conducting natural hazard mitigation planning, updating the Emergency Operations Plan, providing public education and outreach, training and exercising city staff on emergency planning procedures.
