2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation

This ordinance authorizes an agreement with River Campus Investors and North Macadam Investors that will lay out the terms under which the City will acquire two parcels which will be developed as part of the South Waterfront Central District Greenway Trail, and it allows the City to acquire the property through eminent domain.
