## 7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize a six month extension of the Comcast I-Net/IRNE Interconnection Agreement. The institutional network (I-NET) was constructed pursuant to cable franchises issued by the City of Portland and presently operated by Comcast entities. The I-NET was interconnected to the City of Portland's IRNE network in 2002 pursuant to Ordinance No. 176579, passed by the Council June 5, 2002. Ordinance No. 176579 authorizes Agreement No. 51785 between AT&T Broadband of Ohio LLC & TCI Cablevision of Oregon Inc. to provide regional broadband services options to local governments, schools and public agencies throughout Multnomah County.

The Comcast cable franchises under which Comcast I-NET facilities and services are required expire December 31, 2010 and are currently the subject of renewal negotiations with Comcast conducted by staff of the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission (MHCRC). At a meeting held October 18, 2010, the MHCRC recommended the City of Portland and other MHCRC-Comcast Jurisdictions extend the term of the current Comcast cable franchises to June 30, 2011, to allow for orderly conclusion of the current franchise renewal negotiations.

## 8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The city will continue make payments to Comcast, however passage of this ordinance will enable the City to continue to receive revenue by providing broadband service options to local governments, schools and agencies throughout the region.

## 9. <u>RECOMMENDATION/ACTION REQUESTED</u>

Approve the Comcast-IRNE/INET contract extension through June 2011 to allow time to complete the current franchise renewal negotiations.
