ORDINANCE No. 184240

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to award Oregon Military Department Office of Emergency Management grant funds to the City for an emergency call-out and notification system to protect the continuity of the City's business operations (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The Oregon Military Department Office of Emergency Management (OEM) awarded the EOP Enhancements and Communications Grant #07-225 for the period of November 1, 2007 through January 31, 2011 in the amount of \$461,400 and the Law Enforcement and Terrorism Protection Program (LETPP) Grant #07-169 for the period November 1, 2007 through November 30, 2010 in the amount of \$362,817 to Multnomah County as subgrantee.
- 2. Multnomah County was approved to spend a total of \$83,753 combined from both awards for a notification system.
- 3. In 2009, the City identified a need for an emergency call-out and notification system to protect the continuity of its business operations.
- 4. OEM has agreed that the grant funds awarded to the County for the system may be used to reimburse the City for the system expenses. This will be implemented through Intergovermental Agreement with Multnomah County.

NOW, THERFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the Auditor are authorized to execute an Intergovermental Agreement with Multnomah County.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive Multnoamh County and the City of Portland with the benefits of this agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
