

ORDINANCE NO. 184244

* Authorize subrecipient Intergovernmental Agreement with City of Gresham for \$1,856,455 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program and provide for payment (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. In accordance with the HOME Consortium Agreement (No. 51985), a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
2. There is a total of \$1,952,262 in HOME funds available to Gresham in the Portland Housing Bureau budget, comprised of \$625,127 in FY 2010-11 Gresham HOME funds and \$1,327,135 in FY 2009-10 carryover funds.
3. The City of Gresham will implement a portion of the HOME Program in the amount of \$1,856,455 in accordance with the Budget (Attachment A). The balance of Gresham's HOME Program funding (\$95,807) will be administered by the City of Portland.
4. Funds for this Agreement are available in the approved FY 2010-11 Budget for HOME funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said contract from the HOME grant fund.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt City of Gresham's ability to provide for the HOME Investment Partnership Program; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
