## ORDINANCE No. 184256

\* Authorize application to Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for officer overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division (TSD) makes awards for direct law enforcement capability for court-based probation programs.
- 2. The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for ODOT Transportation Safety Division grant funding.
- 3. ODOT will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division personnel overtime hours worked assisting the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program. The Traffic Division officers will provide direct law enforcement capability to the court-based probation program by conducting warrant sweeps.
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$210,000 shall be provided by funds from City of Portland matching funds in the form of personnel expenses in the FY 2010-11 and FY 2011-2012 budgets of the Police Bureau.
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to ODOT for a grant in the amount of \$70,000, in a form substantially in accordance with the application attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this application may result in not receiving funding. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
