**1) Legislation Title:**

\* Authorize application to Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$70,000 for officer overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program (Ordinance)

**2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:**

The City of Portland, Oregon Police Bureau wishes to apply for ODOT Transportation Safety Division grant funding. The Traffic Division officers will provide direct law enforcement capability to the court-based probation program by conducting warrant sweeps. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011.

**3) Revenue:**

ODOT will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division personnel overtime hours worked assisting the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision program.
