PAL builds partnerships between youth, police and the community through recreational, athletic and educational programs designed to encourage and develop good citizenship, improve the quality of life in the Portland Metropolitan area, and to create solutions to the growing problem of gang involvement and violence among youth. PAL is classified as a public charity under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. PAL has expressed an interest is being added to the list of those organizations eligible to use the payroll deduction system under Code Section 5.08.140. The bureau believes that it is in the City's interest to add PAL to the list of those organizations eligible to use the payroll deduction B.
