

ORDINANCE No. 184261

*Amend contract with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety for child safety seat fitting station services through June 30, 2011 at \$14,000. (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 30000065)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City's Safe Routes to School Program works with schools, neighborhoods, and community organizations to encourage students and families to get to and from school in ways that reduce traffic, increase safety, build strong bodies and clear minds, and provide a cleaner environment.
2. The Alliance for Community Traffic Safety was selected through a competitive bid process to provide child safety seat fitting station services once per month across areas of Portland.
3. The City is interested in having ACTS continue to provide these services and is able to fund child safety seat fitting station services to parents and families in Portland.
4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high, and funds are included in Transportation's FY 10/11.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to amend Contract No. 30000065 with the Alliance for Community Traffic Safety, extending it through June 30, 2011 and adding \$14,000 in a form substantially in accordance with the amendment attached to the original of this ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the existing contract is set to expire on January 30, 2011 and the parties wish to continue providing child safety seat fitting stations without a gap in services; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


