* Accept a grant in the amount of \$310,000 and appropriate \$232,500 for Fiscal Year 2011 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) Regional Training Centers program (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

To accept a grant award from the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training (G.R.E.A.T.) Regional Training Centers program for a grant in the amount of \$310,000 for funding that will continue the West Regional Training Center's (W RTC) assistance to dozens of law enforcement agencies in 11 states in both starting and sustaining the G.R.E.A.T. Program and its four components. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011.

The USDOJ will reimburse the City for program expenses, which include 2.0 FTEs, staff program and office supplies, travel and intra-agency expenses not to exceed the awarded amount of \$310,000.
