ORDINANCE No. 184300

*Accept a \$1,958,651 grant and authorize a grant agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation *Connect*Oregon III Grant program for Oregon Sustainability Streetcar Access Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. On November 20, 2009, Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to the *Connect*Oregon III program, administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), for a grant in the amount of \$1,958,651 for the Oregon Sustainability Streetcar Access Project, which will build a dual streetcar track and improve the substandard pedestrian and bike environment at the site of the Oregon Sustainability Center.
- 2. ODOT has notified the City that it will award a *Connect*Oregon III grant for the Oregon Sustainability Streetcar Access to PBOT in the amount of \$1,958,651.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from ODOT for the Oregon Sustainability Streetcar Access Project in the amount of \$1,958,651 and enter into the grant agreement with ODOT for disbursal of funds, in a form substantially in accordance with the exhibit attached for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217

Business Area - TR00

Bureau Program Expenses - \$1,958,651

- c. The Office of Management Finance (OMF) Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the delay of the 30-day waiting period would extend into next January and would negatively affect the acceptance of the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
