RESOLUTION No. 36834

Authorize the Portland Development Commission to pursue an expansion of the Portland Enterprise Zone to add property at 7700 NE Ambassador Place. (Resolution)

WHEREAS, in March 1987, subsequent to Portland City Council approval, the Portland Development Commission successfully applied to the State of Oregon ("State") for the Oregon Enterprise Zone ("E-Zone") program designation in areas of North and Northeast Portland;

WHEREAS, the E-Zone program provides businesses with a 5-year property tax abatement on the value of capital improvements in exchange for job creation and other public benefits;

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2008, the Portland City Council also authorized PDC to successfully pursue a State of Oregon Electronic Commerce (E-Commerce) designation, which serves as a subset to the E-Zone by allowing companies which conduct over 51% of their business electronically to be eligible for an income tax credit for qualifying investments;

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2009, the City Council adopted a five-year Economic Development Strategy, which, among other things, recommends focusing financial and other support to four (4) industry clusters in Portland, including the software cluster;

WHEREAS, Rentrak Corporation ("Rentrak"), an international software company headquartered in Portland with 230 local employees, is interested in using the E-Zone and E-Commerce tools to remain competitive and expand/retain their employment presence in Oregon, and upgrade operations and technology;

WHEREAS, PDC and the Oregon Business Development Department have collectively worked on solutions to assist the company and determined the E-Zone boundary should be amended to include the Rentrak headquarters at 7700 NE Ambassador Place;

WHEREAS, ORS 285C.115 authorizes the City of Portland, as the E-Zone Sponsor, to amend the E-Zone boundaries to add property to the E-Zone and OAR 123-650-1000 defines how to complete a boundary change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council, as the Portland E-Zone Sponsor, authorizes PDC, as the Portland E-Zone Manager, to complete and submit an application to the Oregon Business Development Department to amend the Portland E-Zone boundary, adding the property at 7700 NE Ambassador Place to the E-Zone; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
