## ORDINANCE No.

\*Authorize Price Agreements with Wilkins Trucking Company, Inc. and Knife River to provide aggregate materials and related services for a 5-year contractual total not to exceed \$7,000,000 and \$3,000,000 respectively. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Water Bureau and Portland Bureau of Transportation are routinely involved in excavation work for scheduled, routine, and emergency projects to maintain the City's infrastructure. Construction standards require that they backfill these excavations with approved aggregate materials as well as remove and dispose of the original excavated material (construction spoils).
- 2. The most cost effective way to meet this need is to procure, on a long term contractual basis, the needed materials and construction spoils disposal so as to continue an uninterruptible source of supply and efficient operation. This source of supply, based on a competitive solicitation, ensures the best value for taxpayers of the City of Portland.
- 3. ITB #112000 was issued in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33 on August 6, 2010 for Aggregate Materials and Related Services and five bids were received. Multiple awards will be made, of which Wilkins Trucking Company, Inc. and Knife River are the most centrally located to the work performed. These central locations will result in more orders being placed with Wilkins and Knife River since travel time, labor time, and equipment usage will be optimized by making shorter trips to most projects. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Award Price Agreements to Wilkins Trucking Company, Inc. and Knife River on September 23, 2010.
- 4. Wilkins Trucking Company, Inc. and Knife River have current City of Portland business licenses, are in compliance with the Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certifications are current. Wilkins is located in Portland, Oregon, and Knife River is headquartered in Tangent, OR; neither company is an Oregon certified MWESB contractor.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute Price Agreements on behalf of the City with Wilkins Trucking Company, Inc. for \$1,400,000 per year and not to exceed \$7,000,000 for the 5-year contract period and Knife River for \$600,000 per year and not to exceed \$3,000,000 for the 5-year contract period.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the contractors for the contracts and chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the materials and services described under this ordinance must be continued as quickly as possible in order to maintain current Water Bureau and Portland Bureau of Transportation maintenance operations. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
