

ORDINANCE No. 184343

Authorize a contract with PB Americas, Inc. for engineering services for the design of the SW Parallel Interceptor Odorous Air Control and Treatment Project No. E10121 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to perform professional engineering services for the design of the SWPI Odorous Air Control and Treatment, Project No. E10121.
2. The consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP #BES110). The consultant selection committee recommends that PB Americas, Inc. (Parsons Brinckerhoff) be retained to perform the required professional engineering services.
3. The estimated cost is \$468,715. M/W/ESB participation is \$107,390 or 22.9% of the total contract amount. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10121.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:


- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute a contract with PB Americas, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$468,715.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


