

ORDINANCE NO. 184365

Adopt a Waste Reduction Program and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to receive Metro Waste Reduction Challenge Funds of \$261,397 and \$509,141 for the Recycle at Work Program in FY 10-11 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability Solid Waste and Recycling Program has undertaken an Annual Waste Reduction Program for FY 10-11 (see Exhibit A).
2. Metro provides Challenge funds to local governments for undertaking specific activities as part of an Annual Waste Reduction Program.
3. The City of Portland is eligible to receive \$261,397 from Metro Waste Reduction Challenge funds in FY 10-11.
4. Metro also provides funds to local governments for undertaking specific activities as part of a Recycle at Work program.
5. The City of Portland is eligible to receive \$509,141 to support the Recycle at Work program in FY 10-11.
6. Beginning in FY 10-11, the Challenge funds are made available to the City of Portland through an intergovernmental agreement that also includes Metro funding to support the Recycle at Work program.

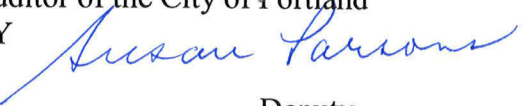
NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Annual Waste Reduction Program shall be adopted as shown in an agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Metro for the purpose described in Section 1.
