ORDINANCE No. 184366

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$24,876 and appropriate \$18,000 for FY 2010-11 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs Bulletproof Vest Partnership FY 2010 grant for bulletproof vests (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP) Bulletproof Vest Partnership for a grant in the amount of \$53,750 for the purchase of 100 ballistic vests for bureau personnel on May 25, 2010; and
- 2. The United States Department of Justice has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the purchase of 74 ballistic vests to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$24,875.82; and
- 3. Fiscal Year 2010 Bulletproof Vest Partnership funds may only be used toward the purchase of vests ordered on or after April 1, 2010. Each vest purchased must meet the National Institute of Justice (NIJ) Standard of 0101.06 on the date it was ordered. Vests must be received and the request for payment submitted to the Bulletproof Vest Partnership online system by August 31, 2012; and
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$24,875.82 will be provided by funds from FY 2010/11 and FY 2011/12 Police Bureau program budget appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the United States Department of Justice for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership FY 2010 grant in the amount of \$24,875.82.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund - 217 Business Area - PL00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$18,000

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the United States Department of Justice for the Bulletproof Vest Partnership FY 2010 grant provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
