## ORDINANCE No. 184367

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$70,000 and appropriate \$53,000 for FY 2010-11 for the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for sworn personnel overtime in order to assist the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division for the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program grant for sworn personnel overtime on December 1, 2010; and
- 2. The Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$70,000; and
- 3. The Oregon Department of Transportation will reimburse the City a maximum of \$70,000 for expenses incurred by the bureau for Traffic Division personnel overtime hours worked. The Traffic Division officers will provide direct law enforcement capability to the court-based probation program by conducting warrant sweeps; and
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$210,000 shall be provided by funds from City of Portland matching funds in the form of personnel expenses in the FY 2010-11 and FY 2011-2012 budgets of the Police Bureau; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program in the amount of \$70,000.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

  <u>GRANTS FUND</u>

  Fund 217

Business Area - PL00

Dusiness Area - 1 Loo

Bureau Program Expenses - \$53,000

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Multnomah County DUII Intensive Supervision Program, 164AL-11-14-17, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
