ORDINANCE No. 184971

Accept a grant in the amount of \$2,445,563 from the Oregon Department of Transportation and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement for the design of the NE 102nd Ave: NE Glisan to SE Washington Phase II. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Metro 2040 Plan identified the Gateway Area as the only Regional Center in the City of Portland designated for higher density mixed use development. 102nd Avenue is the main street in the Gateway Regional Center.
- 2. The Gateway Regional Center Plan prepared in 1999 identified improvements to 102nd Avenue as a key element in a package of transportation improvements for the Gateway Regional Center.
- 3. The Portland Development Commission established the Gateway Urban Renewal District in 2001 to encourage development in the Gateway Regional Center Area. The plan reinforced the importance of improvements along 102nd Avenue. The City Council approved the 102nd Streetscape Plan in November 2005.
- 4. The Gateway Urban Renewal Advisory Committee in cooperation with the Portland Bureau of Transportation applied for and received federal funds to conduct preliminary engineering for the first phase of the NE 102nd Avenue Improvement Project. Phase I has been completed.
- 5. This Agreement will authorize \$2,445,563 of federal funds for Preliminary Engineering, Right of Way and Construction for the NE 102nd Avenue Improvement Project phase II.
- 6. The Portland Development Commission has agreed to provide the \$244,556 necessary to match the federal funds.
- 7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate. The project is in design phase; the scope is known but lacks some details.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation and to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to provide Urban Renewal Funds for completion of the design of the NE 102nd Avenue Project Phase II,

substantially in accordance with the Agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance, and by reference made a part hereof.

b. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
