## **Relocating Water Avenue**

- New alignment facilitates streetcar connections to future light rail bridge
- Allows expansion of OMSI and Portland Opera
- Minimizes conflict with industrial users by moving traffic to eastern edge of district
- Allows "old" Water Ave to become centerpiece of development

## SE Water Ave TSP Classification Change

- Move designation for primary circulation to new roadway
- Retain local street designations for existing street to Caruthers
- Remove future street designation between Caruthers and Division
- Greenway trail designation along river unchanged

  - Outlines project scope and implementation approach
- Conceptual funding plan
  - Project nearly fully funded
- TriMet ready to include project in next stage of PMLRT design
