

ORDINANCE No. 184376

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County not to exceed \$125,000 to fund a Deputy District Attorney to address the problem of prostitution in East Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City and Multnomah County (County) are committed to addressing the problem of prostitution in East Portland.
2. The City utilizes the services of the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office and desires to partner in this effort.
3. The City wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County to fund 1.0 FTE Deputy District Attorney for an amount not to exceed \$125,000.
4. The term of the agreement is July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Multnomah County substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily deprive the City and County of the mutual benefits of this agreement. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
