- 3. Historically the FPD&R liaison has been paid at the Fire Training Officer pay rate.
- 4. PF&R wants to expand recruitment efforts for this assignment to include any sworn member below the rank of captain

Therefore, the parties agree:

- 1. The City and PFFA agree to add the assignment of FPD&R Liaison to the list of assignments in Article 8 Section C Paragraph 2 of the PFFA contract that receive specialty pay.
- 2. This agreement is non-precedent setting.
- 3. PFFA acknowledges that this agreement is subject to the approval of City Council and shall not become effective until approved.
