

ORDINANCE No. 184391

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to receive sponsorship for Bureau of Planning and Sustainability ReTHINK educational series and Build it Green! Home Tour in the amount of \$8,000 in FY 10-11 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. The City of Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability's Green Building Program has implemented the ReTHINK educational series and the Build It Green! Tour of Homes and Information Fair to promote strategies that encourage green development in Portland.
2. The Green Building Program supplies technical assistance, educational programs, tours and grants to commercial and residential projects in Portland that demonstrate methods and innovations in reducing construction impacts, conserving natural resources, and encouraging reduction, reuse and recycling of materials.
3. Metro proposes to provide financial support for the City's programs because they are consistent with its solid waste and recycling objectives in the areas of construction and demolition debris recycling and initiatives for construction and demolition waste reduction.
4. The City of Portland is eligible to receive \$8,000 in FY 10-11 to support the ReThink educational series and the Build It Green! Home Tours.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Metro in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2010-11 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217007

Business Area – PN00

Bureau Program Expenses – \$8,000

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because acceptance of funds allows for continuing educational opportunities for Portland residents that benefit the City's health and welfare. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
