* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Office of Healthy Homes and Lead Hazard Control for the Portland Healthy Homes Program. (Ordinance)

2) Purpose of the Proposed Legislation:

This Ordinance accepts and appropriates \$1,000,000 in funding awarded to the Portland Housing Bureau under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Healthy Homes grant program.

3) Revenue:

This legislation will increase grant revenue coming to the City of Portland in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the period of March 1, 2011-February 28, 2013.

Match for the Portland Healthy Homes grant in the amount of \$586,000 is being provided by local government and nonprofit partners for the grant as well as an in-kind contribution of staff time from the Portland Housing Bureau in the amount of \$34,000.
