- * Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the University of Washington for participation in a University fire prevention research program (Ordinance; Contract No. 30001935)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The University of Washington (UW), through its Health Promotion Research Center is currently operating a pilot research program "Integrated Risk Management Fire Prevention Program" (Program) to reduce the number of fire-related fatalities, injuries, and property loss, by visiting high risk homes and educating the residents about alarm maintenance, escape plans, and fire safety measures.
2. The UW desires to include Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) in its research program, and provide smoke alarms to PF&R for distribution within the City of Portland.
3. Under this Program UW will provide up to 500 smoke alarms to PF&R at no cost, reimburse PF&R up to \$9,720 for personnel costs, \$300 for installation materials, \$200 for public education handouts, \$200 for printed materials such as posters, door hangers, and flyers, \$2,000 for four (4) iPads, and up to \$8,000 for media outreach in neighborhood and minority community newspapers.
4. PF&R currently operates a Smoke Alarm program to provide smoke alarms in the homes of residents of the City of Portland.
5. The Fire Chief recommends that Council authorize this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner In Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the University of Washington in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by this Program, and increase the fire and life safety in Portland.


