ORDINANCE NO. 184454

Authorize application to the Emerald Cities Collaborative, Inc. for a \$75,000 grant to develop and implement a sustainable effort with local organizations to retrofit large scale buildings (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Emerald Cities Collaborative, Inc. (ECC) is a national nonprofit that provides technical assistance, organizing, planning, capacity building, and financing services to help local sustainable development efforts and is supported in its work by charitable foundations including Neighborhood Works Organization and Enterprise Foundation.
- 2. ECC has \$75,000 available to support Portland Emerald Cities Collaborative and requested that the Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) assist in making these funds available.
- 3. PHB is committed to working collaboratively to develop resources that assist in the development and preservation of affordable housing.
- 4. PHB will use the funds to contract with Portland Emerald Cities Collaborative to fulfill the requirements of the grant to develop and implement a 3-year strategic plan to institutionalize a local collaborative of organizations committed to greening the city's economy through retrofits of large scale buildings, including affordable and market rate housing, in order to produce significant carbon reductions, jobs, and social equity.
- 5. No match is required by this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director is hereby authorized to make application to ECC for a grant of \$75,000.
- b. The Bureau Director is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
