

ORDINANCE No. 184469

*Authorize grant agreements of \$28,138 for East Portland Neighbors, \$1,250 for Parkrose Heights United Methodist Church and \$9,633 for North Portland Community Works to administer Neighborhood Small Grants and communications funds (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Neighborhood Small Grants Program provides neighborhood and community organizations an opportunity to expand their community-building capacity, attract new and diverse members and sustain those already involved.
- 2. This program has been adopted as part of the FY 2010-11 Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) budget and is funded with a total of \$116,530 through City General Fund dollars.
- 3. Two of the seven neighborhood District Coalitions, which are city-administered offices—East Portland Neighborhood Office and North Portland Neighborhood Services—are to administer their grant dollars and distribute funds to grantees. Those grantees are respectively East Portland Neighbors (EPN), Parkrose Heights United Methodist Church, and Kenton Action Plan (dba “North Portland Community Works” (NPCW).


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a) The Director of the ONI is authorized and directed to enter into grant agreements in forms substantially in accordance with the grant agreements attached as Exhibits A through C.
- b) Amendments to the grant agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Director of ONI or his/her designee provided those amendments do not increase the fiscal risk to the City.
- c) The Commissioner in Charge and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said grant agreements from the Office of Neighborhood Involvement general funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in granting these awards would negatively impact the timely implementation of these community-initiated projects; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
